Check Your Eligibility

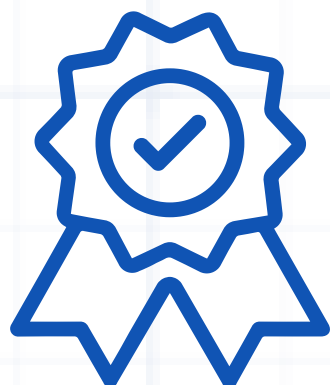
- Confirm your healthcare qualification (nursing, aged care, disability support, etc.)
- Determine if your qualification is recognized in Australia
- Research visa options (Skilled Visa 482, 186, or Working Holiday Visa)

Qualification Recognition

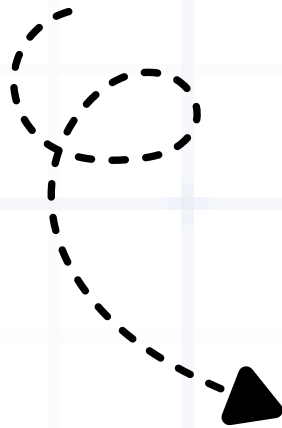
- Register or apply with AHPRA (Australian Health Practitioner Regulation Agency) if required
- Get qualifications assessed through ANMAC or a relevant body
- Prepare documents:
Degree/diploma certificates / Transcripts /
Employment references / English test results
NCLEX test results / OSCE test results

English Language Requirements

- English Language Requirements
- OET (Occupational English Test)
- IELTS (minimum 7.0 overall, no band less than 7 for nurses)
- Provide valid results (usually valid for 2 years)

Job Search & Sponsorship

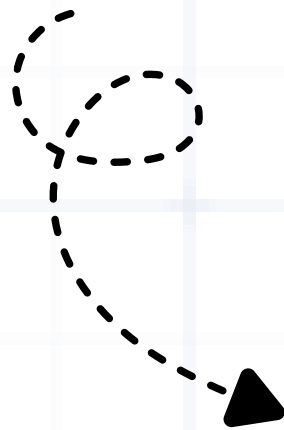
- Prepare an Australian-style resume and cover letter
- Register with healthcare recruitment agencies or job boards (Seek, Indeed, Healthcare Australia)
- Attend interviews (in person or online)
- Secure a job offer and employer sponsorship (if applicable)

- Choose the appropriate visa type:
- Temporary Skill Shortage (Subclass 482)
- Skilled Independent (Subclass 189)
- Employer Nomination (Subclass 186)



- Gather required documents:
- Passport
- Skills assessment result
- English test
